Learning Objective:

Mr. Buttons Poem



Push the button through the door, Use your other hand to pull some more.

See! Mr. Buttons made it through, That was all you had to do!



Concept Details

You have to work with your ward on a table top with sitting on a chair, which will give him extra stability while he works.



Lay out the piece of the cloth on the table with the collar closes to your child, so it faces the way it will when it's on his body.



Concept activity

- Start at the bottom of the shirt. Let your child push the button through the button hole while you hold the fabric.
- Encourage him to hold the fabric and push the button through the button hole.



Once he has learnt to button the shirt on the table, he can put on the clothing and try doing it for real.
